

# WMSP RiderCoach Licensing Professional Development Activities

Please note that some of the motorcycle rider education courses described below are still being developed.

A (PDW) Professional Development Workshop activity must include:

- A minimum of 80% of the workshop, activity, or event must be devoted to rider education curriculum training, either classroom, range, or both. It may be devoted to one or a variety of rider education curriculums.
- Licensing activities must be a minimum of eight (8) consecutive hours or a minimum of twelve (12) non-consecutive total hours gained through a variety of activities over the WMSP three-year certification period.

Some activities will require prior approval by the Wisconsin Motorcycle Safety Program (WMSP) in order to qualify as a licensing activity. All activities will also require proof of participation and documentation as specified below.

- **If you are unsure of the appropriateness of an activity, it is recommended that you obtain prior approval from the WMSP. Please contact your WMSP Regional RiderCoach Trainer or the WMSP Manager.**
- **Any activity NOT listed in this document will require prior approval to qualify as an acceptable WMSP professional development activity.**
- **Remember to document the date and location of your recertification activity. Record date and location specific information on the recertification forms.**

Examples of activities that do not require prior approval, but will require documented proof of participation:

- Activities sponsored by the Wisconsin Motorcycle Safety Program (WMSP), the Motorcycle Safety Foundation (MSF) or Corporate Harley-Davidson's Riding Academy department:
- WMSP Professional Development Workshop (PDW) for RiderCoaches
- WMSP/MSF Quality Assurance Specialist (QAS) Training
- WMSP State-wide Motorcycle Safety & Awareness Conference
- MSF PDW for RiderCoaches
- MSF National or Regional Conference for RiderCoaches/RiderCoach Trainers
- Harley-Davidson Riding Academy Coach Continuous Improvement Workshops (CIW)

Other acceptable activities or events that do not require prior approval:

- Participation in (receiving RiderCoach qualification or certification) WMSP/MSF RiderCoach Certification or Qualification Courses:
  - Advanced RiderCourse (ARC) (24 hour credit)
  - 3-Wheel Basic RiderCourse (3WBRC) (32 hour credit)
  - Street RiderCourse (SRC-2) (32 hour credit)
  - Basic RiderCourse-2 (BRC-2u) (8 hour credit)
  - Returning Rider Basic RiderCourse (RRBRC) (12 hour credit)
  - Ultimate Bike-Bonding RiderCourse (UBBRC) (12 hour credit)
  - Basic Bike-Bonding RiderCourse (BBBRC) (12 hour credit)
- Participation in (receiving RiderCoach qualification) WMSP/MSF RiderCoach Qualification Courses:
  - Safe Motorcyclist Awareness & Reaction Trainer (SMARTrainer) (4 hour credit) NOTE: Requires on-line MSF Qualification Exam as well as WMSP hands-on training.

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- Participation (as a student) in one or more of the following Courses:
  - The BRC (updated) Curriculum (16 hour credit) **MAY NOT BE TAKEN AT YOUR HOME SITE! Must include eCourse Certificate**
  - Advanced RiderCourse (ARC) (8 hour credit) (Civilian or Military version)
  - 3-Wheel Basic RiderCourse (3WBRC) (16 hour credit)
  - Introduction to Scooters Course (IS) (4 hour credit)
  - Scooter Basic RiderCourse (SBRC) (16 hour credit)
  - Basic Bike-Bonding RiderCourse (BBBRC) (8 hour credit)
  - Ultimate Bike-Bonding RiderCourse (UBBRC) (8 hour credit)
  - Basic RiderCourse-2 (BRC-2) (8 hour credit) **Must include Street Strategies eCourse.**
  - Returning Rider Basic RiderCourse (RRBRC) (4 hour credit)
  - DirtBike School (DBS): DirtBike BasicRiderCourse or Trail Riding RiderCourse (4 hour credit)
  - The Kevin Schwantz RiderCourse (KSRC) (8 hour credit)
  - Basic eCourse (3 hour credit)
  - Street Strategies eCourse ( 1.5 hour credit)
  - Ultimate Bike Bonding Plus (UBBRC+)(8 hour credit)

Other possible options for re-certification. NOTE: These activities must be preapproved by the WMSP:

- Mentoring an inexperienced RiderCoach (each hour of activity earns 1/2 hour of credit). You must provide date, time, location, name of RiderCoach mentored, and description of activity.
- Participation in, and successful completion of, some other motorcycle rider education type of activity. You must provide a syllabus, curriculum outline, or course outline and certificate of completion. A minimum of 8 hours of training required.
  - Examples:
    - Total Control Advanced Riding Clinic
    - Ride Like A Pro Rider Classes
- Participation in a structured/formal road racing school. You must provide a syllabus, curriculum outline, or course outline and certificate of completion. A minimum of 8 hours of training required.
  - Examples:
    - (WERA) Western Eastern Road-Racing Association
    - Learning Curves Road-Racing School
